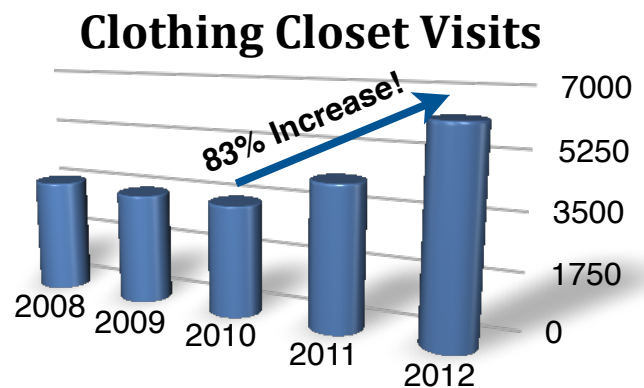
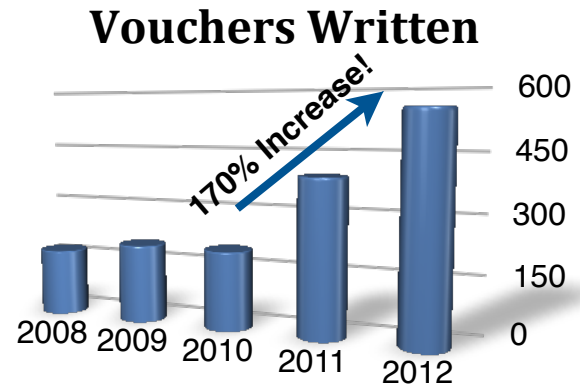


# ELCA Urban Outreach Center 2012 Annual Report

## Outreach Programs

- Over 1,660 individual clients were served by the Center at least once.
- 166 people received free legal advice from seven attorneys providing pro-bono service.
- 555 Prescription Co-Pay vouchers were written for a total of \$12,325 in Kenosha and Western Kenosha County.
- Computers, phone, fax and internet were used over 6,250 times to find employment, medical assistance or housing. This is an increase of 90% over 2011.

## Youth Programs

- 46 grade school children participated in Summer Camp with six college students leading the camp and six high school student helping.

## Youth Programs (cont.)

- 230 children received school supplies in August to be ready for the new school year.
- Thanks to many generous organizations, churches and individuals 1,170 children received Christmas gifts through the Center.
- 130 children attended the annual Christmas party along with their parents.
- 15 girls participated in bi-monthly Girlz Together activities.

## Adult Education Programs

- Attendance for the GED class increased 43% in 2012 over 2011.
- Six individuals received their GED in 2012.
- Each week, the Center collaborates with the Job Center to provide a self-improvement workshop designed to improve clients lives and help them become self-sufficient.
- In collaboration with KUSD, the Center hosts monthly Chat-n-Chews on life skills.
